## ***Κoinōνία (Koinonia)***

koinō' nēā, noun: Christian fellowship

*Create in me a clean heart, O God,  
and put a new and right spirit within me.  
Do not cast me away from your presence,  
and do not take your holy spirit from me.  
Restore to me the joy of your salvation,  
and sustain in me a willing spirit.*  
(Psalm 51:10-12, NRSV)

A new year has begun! This is an opportunity to pause and reflect over the days of the previous 12 months and to consider where we might go and what we might do in the next 12.

Did you set any goals in 2019? Did you make any commitments to grow? Did you lose those 10 pounds? Did you improve your diet, join a gym or make a decision to improve yourself in some other meaningful way? Did you get out of debt? How did you do?

Certainly, we have all had successes, and surely we have all fallen short. If you are one of the rare people who reached every goal, congratulations!

For 2020, what are your goals for growth and self-improvement? If you are serious about reaching your goals, I have a few suggestions: 1.) write them down and look at them often; 2.) define what success specifically looks like, in other words, write down the dollar amount you are trying to earn so that you can pay down debt, target a specific amount of weight you want to lose, name the three people you want to reconcile and reconnect with this year; 3.) write the strategy you are going to use to get to those goals, identify the short-term milestones and celebrate the reaching of each step; 4.) take action daily, no matter how small; and 5.) keep perspective. Most people overestimate what they can accomplish in one year and therefore get discouraged, but they underestimate what they can accomplish in a decade and therefore squander their potential. So be patient and persistent. Finally, know that many hands make light work, so share your goals with

others, find encouragement and accountability partners and collaborate. Going to the gym with a friend is so much more sustainable than going it alone. And it's more fun!

At this moment of reflection and resolve, let us as a family of faith make a commitment for the coming year together. 2020 can be the year that we take the ministry of First Christian Church to the next level. This can be the year that we grow our Sunday School classes, increase worship attendance, make a bigger impact in the community, and deepen our connection with God and each other. I challenge and encourage you to think of one or two things that you can do to fulfill our calling to "make disciples who make a difference." You can commit to more church engagement, start inviting neighbors to worship, join a ministry, volunteer, sing in the choir, join a 9:45 am Sunday School class (there's a new one that I'm teaching in room 209), increase your giving, start a new fellowship group that meets at a coffee shop or your home one evening a week or month, or anything else God might be calling you to do to serve the Kingdom. The possibilities are endless and the path is easier than you think. All we need is a specific goal, a plan to get there, and patient, persistent action taken daily. God is faithful and will do the rest.

## ***December Board Summary***

- November Financial Report: Contributions were less than budget for November and greater than budget year to date. Expenses were greater than budget for November. This year's income from the Endowment Fund slated for the General Budget was used to pay debt associated with HVAC project. Budget is expected to balance at year end. Emergency Fund: \$5000.00 for remaining amount insurance didn't pay for lightning strike damage to sound system; an estimated cost of \$3000.00 is expected to repipe the gas line that was cut off during original repair of gas leak; and an estimated cost of \$8000.00 is expected for new copier.
- Personnel: Board approved five (5) weeks of vacation pay for associate pastor; board approved revision to the current Health Insurance Policy; board approved final draft of Volunteer Facility Wedding Coordinator definition; board approved the revised Funeral Policy and Funeral Fees.
- Senior Minister: Average attendance is 165; last eight (8) weeks is 180, reflecting a positive upward trend. On-line giving is live this week and information will be placed in the Highlights this week.
- Board approved recommended constitutional changes regarding the Discipleship Ministry Area Coordinator. A second reading will take place at January 2020 board meeting.
- A focus for 2020 will be on filling the Associate Pastor position.
- Board approved a request from Adult Day Care Health Services to utilize FCC as a temporary contingent location if their facility is temporarily uninhabitable or unsafe.
- Proposed changes in the Love Fund Policy were reviewed and decision was made to send it back to Love Fund Committee for further review and clarification.
- Outreach: Breakfast with Santa and the Salvation Army Angel Tree and Bell Ringing were all successful.
