Rooftop

Growing bodies of evidence show mobile devices, created with intentions of enhancing interactions, are instead altering social behavior in counterintuitive ways. Friends remain on their phones when together. Answering either a text or a ringing phone at dinner, or in a meeting, is less likely to be viewed as an interruption than just a few years ago. Devices created with the intention of fostering communication now seem to be furthering qualities of poor communication, or in some cases, no communication at all.

Upon reading an article by Jill Carattini, I was made aware one major company has introduced what it refers to as an added "functionality" for its subscribers: a service to enable bailing out on a date or other social engagement. Subscribers arrange for their phones to be contacted at an arranged time. The call then guides the subscriber through an automated "escape script" allowing the person to talk their way out of being with the unsuspecting date or event. The evening comes to a sudden end in order for the subscriber to dash off to look after an urgent issue. Now, if the date is going well and if the event proves worthwhile, the call is simply not answered.

There is a phrase from Psalm 129:6-7 that comes to mind upon reading of the "emerging functionalities" which come into our lives and shred true functioning. The psalmist is referring to the deceptive, to the wicked, to those who work against God's kingdom. Crying out to God the psalmist asks, "Let them be like grass on the rooftops that withers before it grows up, with which reapers do not fill their hands or binders of sheaves their arms."

In the crevices of the flat roofs of Mideast houses grass springs up, seeming almost defiant about its heightened position in rebellious places. Like the tufts of grass that seem to tirelessly fight back to own a place in the cracks of our sidewalks and driveways, grass on the rooftop stubbornly declares

its unwanted existence requiring attention.

At first glance, it seems an odd request. Why would we ask God to make those against the Lord to be like the annoying grass we must unremittingly fight every growing season? The conclusions seem disheartening. Will the intolerance that endlessly springs forth in the cracks of curbs, driveways, and sidewalks of society ever cease? Will ignorant prejudice and wickedness that grows like weeds ever be rooted out?

The psalmist's colorful description reminds us that it will not. But in the image of grass upon a roof, the psalmist wisely bids us to see more. In the words of Alexandre Dumas, "Until the day comes when God will deign to reveal the future to [hu]man[ity], all human wisdom is contained in these words: Wait and hope!"

The weeds of judgmental hatefulness and intolerance will remain, but like grass on a rooftop, it will never be grass growing as intended, or even as it might hope. Communication offered through escape scripts is not communication and eventually will collapse under its own deceit.

Grass on a rooftop cannot fill the reaper's hands nor can it fill the gatherer's arms. It may boast in its rebellious standing, but having shallow roots and nowhere to grow, it cannot endure. It bears no fulfillment, nothing to cut or to carry, nothing for the hand to grasp, nothing that will last.

So, indeed, may those who work against the kingdom of God and life as the Lord intended to be like grass on a rooftop.


