In "Good Economics for Hard Times: Better Answers to Our Biggest Problems" authors Abhijit Banerjee and Esther Duflo, two of the three winners of 2019's Nobel Prize in Economics, reminds there are only three ways a society is able to generate wealth: farming, mining and manufacturing.

I feel this core truth is key to understanding the world's greatest work ethic which is found right here in the United States. For both the country and its individual citizens God has a message through Jesus' in Luke 12:13-21 (MSG):

13 Someone out of the crowd said, "Teacher, order my brother to give me a fair share of the family inheritance." 14 He replied, "Mister, what makes you think it's any of my business to be a judge or mediator for you?" 15 Speaking to the people, he went on, "Take care! Protect yourself against the least bit of greed. Life is not defined by what you have, even when you have a lot." **16-19** Then he told them this story: "The farm of a certain rich man produced a terrific crop. He talked to himself: 'What can I do? My barn isn't big enough for this harvest.' Then he said, 'Here's what I'll do: I'll tear down my barns and build bigger ones. Then I'll gather in all my grain and goods, and I'll say to myself, Self, you've done well! You've got it made and can now retire. Take it easy and have the time of your life!'

20 "Just then God showed up and said, 'Fool! Tonight you die. And your barnful of goods—who gets it?'

21 "That's what happens when you fill your barn with Self and not with God."

We find ourselves at the turning points of seasons. Crops are ripening in fields while summer wardrobes are being put away for warmer clothes. The time of harvest is near. Today God's Word holds just as powerful truth as when

prophets, apostles and Christ first spoke them.

The ministry at First Christian Church is preparing in every way to rise to the call God gives in the year ahead, and the time beyond. Those answering the call to serve as Elder, Deacon and Trustee will in a few weeks be presented before the congregation for their consideration.

Just as our shared ministry prepares for meeting God's call, so we who believe prepare to respond to God's call with our own life and gifts for the year ahead, and the time beyond.

There are those who yet labour in the field to provide for others and themselves. There are those whose fields have yielded the harvest of a life's hard work. Through God's Word, both are instructed to keep foremost in mind our loving God from whom all blessings flow. We together bring that which God blesses and make it an offering out of which the ministries of Jesus Christ continue forward.

Those in retirement, those whose fields have yielded the harvest of a life's hard work, are called to consider not only the year ahead, but also the time beyond. We are to consider a lifetime of God's providence when considering the time beyond - how to set aside a portion of the accumulated resources which fills our barns with goods. It is an act of faithfulness and witness before God to set aside a portion of God's lifelong bounty blessed and place it into the continuing for the work of the Good News.

In this season of preparation and harvest, consider what part of your barn's goods can be dedicated to the gospel of Jesus Christ upon God's gift of everlasting life. From considerations to actual completion of the task then will we be able to say, "Self, you've done well in fulfillment of your baptismal vows and life of faithfulness. Take it easy and have the time of your everlasting, eternal life."
